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# **Commercial providers in EOSC**



- Contracted via European tender -> 18 Multinational- & 8 National Commercial Cloud providers.
- All framework agreements are available via the EOSC Marketplace and can be compliantly used by all (employees of) eligible institutes and universities.
- Full portfolio of Cloud Services available of all mentioned commercial providers
  - Storage
  - CPU/GPU Virtualisation

  - Machine learning
  - Etc.
- Consultancy and support is available through local reseller (native language support / local billing)
- **Favourable Terms & Conditions** 
  - Pricing
  - Data ingress / egress waiver

  - Bring your own license Connection to NREN / GÉANT Network
  - Easy to use / enroll. Ready to go contracts available





### EOSC <-> Commercial providers Finding the balance



- Cloud business is a standardised and high volume business -> bespoke offerings are rare (or not existent) because of the nature of '*Cloud*.
- Larger Cloud providers work via resellers -> Hyperscalers are reluctant to offer services direct (EC competition laws)
  - Consultancy available via reseller. Does it match requirements of EOSC user?
- GDPR -> one size fits all approach
- For providers it must be economically interesting to get engaged
- Finding the balance between a bespoke solution <-> generic Cloud service

# Initial requirement gathering done via WP9 (2021 / 2022)

- No real specific requirements were identified
- Generic needs:
  - Storage
  - File transfer
  - Virtual machines
- Based on outcome no additional tender was launched

#### **Future requirements?**

- Need for a specific functionality?

  Balance between individual- and
  - Balance between individual- and broadly required requirements
- What is required / desired?
  - GDPR?
  - Data Sovereignty?
- Significant demand -> tender to add required functionality to EOSC
